P. Joseph Titus is a Catholic priest of the Archdiocese of Pondicherry-Cuddalore, and Professor of the Hebrew Bible and was President of St. Peter's Pontifical Institute (Bangalore) in 2017-2023. He holds a *Sacrae Theologiae Doctor* (S.T.D.) from the *Catholic University of Paris*, France and a Ph.D. from the *Catholic University of Leuven*, Belgium. He received *nihil obstat* from the Congregation for Catholic Education, Rome in 2013 and was raised to the rank of a permanent professor. He is Editor of the pace setting *Indian Theological Studies* as well as a member of the Editorial Board of *Transversalités*, a French Theological Journal published by the Catholic University of Paris, France. He was Secretary (2012-2014) and President (2014-2016) of *Society for Biblical Studies in India (SBSI)*. He is a regular contributor to different theological journals published from India and abroad.
